- 1. Treat Others with Respect**
 - a) Always treat athletes, coaches, and members with respect, courtesy and understanding.
- 2. Take Pride in the Selkirk Selects Facility**
 - a) Take care in maintaining the cleanliness of the facility
 - b) Store valuables securely
- 3. Always Speak Positively About Other Athletes, Clubs, and the Sport of Gymnastics**
 - a) Never say anything negative about athletes or clubs, including the Selkirk Selects, or the sport of gymnastics in general to other coaches, gymnasts, parents, the media, members of the general public, or on any social media platform.
 - b) Discuss any issues you may have with your child's coach or leave a note for the board in the lock book.
- 4. Ensure Athletes are Punctual**
 - a) Parents/guardians are responsible for ensuring their athlete arrives for their training session on time and dressed in the appropriate attire
- 5. Communicate Absences**
 - a) Parents/guardians of competitive athletes are responsible for adhering to the absence policy found in the competitive rules
- 6. Inform Coaching Staff of any Injuries**
 - a) Parents/guardians are responsible for informing coaches of any medical concerns or injuries that may affect training
